3. Explain the significance of discipling the nations and how it differs from preaching the gospel in a general way.
4. Explain the significance of baptism in the context of Matthew 28:19 and how our being baptized into the reality of the Divine Trinity is for the constituting of the kingdom of the heavens.
5. Explain the importance of teaching in relation to discipling the nations into the kingdom of God.
